#### Advocacy Training Program Overview:

- 12 foundational courses/year: 4 class sessions/course + optional Q&A at the end of each course
- 7 hours per course- 84 training hours (96 with Q&As)

#### Quiz Links:

- Posted on the course webpage following completion of the 4<sup>th</sup> regular class/course

#### Google Classroom:

- Only need to join if you miss a live class session and need to turn in a brief summary for class attendance
- 5-7 bullet points of the key ideas/ maximum ¾ typed page
- Quizzes also available here

#### Chat:

- Sign-in for attendance – name & location (first name and state are fine)
- We are unable to track/monitor individual attendance, so you can search the chat for your sign-in, if you are unsure whether you attended a particular session.
- Please keep the questions/comments in the chat relevant to the course content for this current class. We will have a Q&A the Saturday after the last class at 12 pm EST.

- If you are finishing your summaries/quizzes from the 2025 training cohort, the 2025 Google classroom will remain open for a few months. After that, it will be archived, and you will be able to see what you have submitted but unable to add anything new. If you still need to submit summaries or quizzes after then, please join either the 2026 Google classroom (link on the course webpages) or the self-paced Google classroom. Once you have gone through all 12 foundational courses the first time, you are welcome to repeat them *for free* as often as you wish. (The course content is updated each year with the latest research prior to presenting the material again.)

Once you have completed courses 1-5 (with encouragement for the 6th course- Trauma Issues), you are welcome to apply to become an affiliated advocate with Called to Peace Ministries.

We will cover some difficult topics in these courses.

- Please remember to take good care of yourself during class. We will have periodic grounding breaks, but you are encouraged to take a break any time you want one. Come back to class/the recording when you're ready.
- Some participants have found it helpful to plan (as much as possible) for a more relaxed/restful afternoon/evening following a live class session (or after watching the replay). This may include an intentionally slower schedule, practicing good self-care, or even a simpler plan for supper (ie: a crockpot meal that was started earlier in the day, leftovers, or take-out).
