QUESTION: Can you elaborate on the following scripture? 2 Timothy 3:6-7 in relation to 3:1-5. Verses 6-7 talk about weak-willed woman, who are loaded down with sins. Can you also elaborate on Isaiah 53:7 about Jesus being oppressed and afflicted, yet he did not open his mouth. Can you explain that scripture in relation to advocacy which we requires us to open our mouths?

*Kendra's input: The Isaiah 53:7 passage - Jesus was silent before His accusers at that time because He knew it was His time to die for the atonement for the sins of those who would believe in Him unto salvation. There were plenty of other times in the Gospel accounts where He spoke up, calling the religious leaders of His day "a brood of vipers" and pointing out their hypocrisy. We have a long list throughout these courses of verses that tell us to "speak up for the oppressed." (Ps 82:3-4, Prov. 31: 8-9, etc.) Also, we need to have a handle on when a passage is indicative (narrative) versus imperative (command for us to follow for all time).*

*Karen's input: 1 Timothy 3:1-9 addresses those who are lovers of themselves, rather than lovers of God. In verse 6, the women who are being captured are referred to as weak or vulnerable. It is not entirely clear whose sins and passions are being addressed. Taken along with verse 7, however, it seems likely the sins and passions belong to those who are lovers of themselves, rather than God.*

I tend to think of the relationship between **forgiveness and reconciliation** like the relationship \ of squares & rectangles:

1. All squares are rectangles, but not all rectangles are squares.
2. Reconciliation will require forgiveness, but not all forgiveness requires reconciliation.
  - o God never said He would set-aside the principles of "sowing & reaping" when two people are married.
  - o Sometimes there is too much damage to the relationship/trust is irreparably broken. (I shared an example of how this plays out in other areas of life at the past couple of PtF's, if you want me to talk about it briefly at the beginning of class.)

Question: Currently I am working with a woman who was in the music industry with one of these types of abusive men. She is happily married, and this man is also married with a family. He began to stalk her and treat her with other components of coercive control (threats to her, threats to himself to commit suicide). He was romantically pursuing her. When the woman brought the situation public and to the church for help. She was told to move on quietly. This man joined a church with her immediate family and professed to love Christ. He has continued to stalk her in public places. The church has refused to step in and help facilitate a meeting of resolve. The victim has been silenced and told to "hope it goes away." It is important to mention this man has a history of this behavior towards other women including forced sex, physical abuse, and even a forced abortion to a victim. Can you give insight since this is a very unique situation? The victim does not feel safe at this point in time.

*Joy has shared: I do address it at the protect the flocks. It simply means it doesn't keep a record of wrongs in order to control or hurt someone. When somebody is keeping a record to protect themselves, it is a different thing. I talk about how women can't get protective orders and so forth if they aren't able to document. So I mostly talk about how it doesn't refer to documentation.*

*Jolene: On forgiveness & keeping a record of wrongs, I have a video that dives into the phrase, "forgive & forget" in my series on Christian Phrases that Keep You Stuck, Hidden, and Hurting.*

*In a situation like this, an advocate can explore the person's concerns about keeping records & her experience with this snippet of scripture. A posture of curiosity (as an advocate) may help her gain clarity on what's happening and what is important to her. For example, she may identify an internal wrestling with what is true (about God, scripture, & God's guidance for her) versus coercive expectations to comply according to what someone else wants.*

*When a coercive controller uses this scripture about not keeping a record of wrongs, consider what it is they are expecting of her. They don't want her to bring up truth about the damaging and dishonoring behaviors the controller engages in. They don't want attention brought to the reality of what is (& has been) happening.*

*Coercive control puts the responsibility of doing wrong & being wrong on to the victim while not taking responsibility for the destructive thoughts & actions they engage in. In addition, they coerce victims to comply with their view & expectations, which keeps the truth from coming to light.*

*Consider Ephesians 5: 6-14 regarding not being fooled by this who excuse their sins, not participating with them, and exposing evil.*

*A coercive controller using scripture this way is an attempt to convince others to not address truth & reality. This is not the heart of God.*

*Recording things that happen can help a victim gain clarity in truth & reality (such as patterns of behavior, destructive cycles, how God really sees her, who God really is). Living in the truth of what is happening helps survivors make choices that support God's heart for them. Also, living in the truth of what is supports the ability to make healthy choices going forward.*
